

**NOTICE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF
LICENSES & INSPECTIONS**

OUTDOOR WOOD BOILERS

BE ADVISED that the Department of Environmental Protection (D.E.P.) issued a compliance advisory regarding outdoor wood boilers referencing the smoke emissions provisions of the D.E.P.'s rules, N.J.A.C. 7:27-3.

Under these rules, smoke from outdoor boilers may be visible for not more than three minutes in any consecutive 30 minute period.

Be further advised you may be subject to some future enforcement action if the outdoor wood boiler does not meet the smoke emissions provision adopted by the D.E.P.

**ISSUANCE OF A U.C.C. PERMIT DOES NOT GUARANTEE
THAT A UNIT WILL MEET THE D.E.P. REQUIREMENTS.**

The Department of Community Affairs has advised that it was brought to their attention that in some instances county Health Departments, acting under the authority of the Department of Environmental Protection, have ordered residents with existing outdoor wood boilers to remove them.

It is suggested that you contact the County Health Department at (856) 327-7080 prior to installing this equipment because they enforce the D.E.P. rules locally and may be able to provide guidance on the D.E.P. requirements.
