



## CITY OF VINELAND TRASH & RECYCLING REGULATIONS

revised 01/08

Collection Days: (2) collection days per district:  
Monday/Thursday; Tuesday/Friday; Wednesday/Saturday

### GENERAL RULES:

All **Trash & Recycling** materials shall be in proper containers and placed neatly at the edge of lawn or curbside. No containers or materials may be placed in the roadway. Containers shall be placed curbside or edge of lawn no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the day before the scheduled collection and must be removed no later than 7:00 p.m. the day of collection.

Trash containers may be metal or plastic **with handles**, or large heavy plastic bags. 55-gallon drums **may not** be used to contain loose trash. Two containers when filled should not exceed 65 lbs. or 6 bags containing household trash, not weighing more than 50 pounds, are permitted per residence per collection day.

Commingled Recyclables & Newspaper/Paper must be placed in the designated **Red recycling containers**. These red containers are provided by the City of Vineland for recyclables **only**.

Prohibited materials: Construction waste, demolition debris, wood pallets, renovation materials, hazardous waste, car parts, tree stumps, animal carcasses, or any type of motors or furnaces are prohibited from curbside pick-up. A private hauler with a NJDEP permit must dispose of these materials or residents can use the Cumberland County Solid Waste Complex. Dumping such material in the woods, on vacant lots, or along roadways is punishable by a fine of \$2,500, or up to a 90 day jail term and/or community service.

### DEFINITIONS:

Garbage-meat or vegetable solids from residential properties.

Trash-any article or refuse material generated by a household residence in the ordinary course of living, i.e., rubbish, cold ashes, old clothing, household redecorating refuse, i.e., rugs, curtains, blinds, etc., and discarded household utensils, and bulky items such as household furniture, mattresses & box springs.

Commingled Recyclables: **Glass:** all green, brown, & clear glass food containers and jars (no blue glass). Caps and lids must be removed and disposed of with regular trash. **Metals:** aluminum, tin and metal food and beverage containers, and empty aerosol containers (remove plastic lid if possible). **Plastic:** soda, milk and water containers and any detergent containers with the #1 or #2 symbol on the bottom.

Newspaper/magazines-all newsprint, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, glossy inserts or unwanted mail. Do Not Mix any cardboard, food & beverage boxes or brown paper bags in this container.

Bulky Waste-Household furniture, mattresses and box springs, etc., will be collected on your regular trash days.

### PREPARATION OF MATERIAL FOR PICK-UP:

Cardboard Containers-Large boxes from appliances or other large products must be cut to 3'x3'-then tied and bundled or dropped off at one of our convenient drop off locations. Check our website for locations and times.

Boards, Pipes - must be tied securely into bundles not exceeding 5 ft. in length, weighing not more than 55 lbs. No more than 2 bundles of any specific material per collection day.

Brush & Branches - only 2-3 small bundles of branches or twigs not exceeding three (3) feet will be picked up on trash day. They must be tied & bundled as stated above. During specified Spring or Fall pick-up times only, large amounts can be placed at curb (not in roadway) on scheduled days to be picked up by the Road Dept.

Grass Clippings-place in plastic bags, but **do not mix** with leaves or other debris. Bags must not weight more than 40lbs!

Leaves-can be loose or bagged, and placed curbside (not in roadway), for **designated pick up seasons only**. Otherwise residents can bring them to the FREE Material Handling Facility on Mill Road. **NO LOT CLEARANCES ALLOWED**. At any time, you may use the FREE Material Handling Facility on Mill Road to drop off these items. You can also drop off cardboard and electronics at this location and our Public Works Yard. Check our website or request a brochure for hours of operation.

Newspapers - **New procedure!** Place newspaper, magazines, catalogues, telephone books, glossy insert & unwanted mail in the **NEW Red Paper Recycling Bin** provided to every resident. Put it at the curb on your designated recycling day.

Rugs/Floor Coverings -must be cut into lengths not exceeding 6ft, folded /rolled, & tied securely with rope or cord.

White Goods & Tires: are collected the first **FULL week** of each month on your recycling day. Place at the curb the night before to ensure pick up. **Tires:** from personal standard vehicles, no larger than 17", with or without rims. Maximum six (6) per collection day not to exceed eighteen (18) tires per household per year. **White Goods** are any appliances designated for household use, i.e., refrigerators, washers, dryers, air conditioners, water heaters, humidifiers, trash compactors, etc.
