MEET YOUR NEW RECYCLING CART CARTS ARRIVE STARTING DECEMBER 2018

Your new recycling cart will have two wheels for easy maneuvering and a lid to keep things tidy. It's going to make recycling easier and help you recycle more items—a true win-win for residents.

Carts will be dropped off at your residence starting in December along with more information about the program.

WHERE DO I STORE MY RECYCLING CART?

Please store your cart behind or beside your home, on or under your back porch, or inside your garage. Do not store them on the sidewalk in front of your home or at the curb.

MY CART IS TOO BIG. CAN I GET A SMALLER ONE?

Residents must use the 96 gallon cart for the first quarter of the year (January-March 2019). After March, senior citizens or residents with disabilities will be eligible to exchange their cart for a smaller model.

A RECYCLING CART WAS DELIVERED TO MY HOME BUT I DO NOT WANT IT. WILL YOU TAKE IT BACK?

No. Residents must use the cart delivered for all recycling moving forward. If recyclables are placed in another receptacle, such as the old red bins, they will not be picked up.

WHAT DO I DO WITH MY OLD BIN?

Old bins can be taken to our Material Handling Facility at 1271 S. Mill Road or the Public Works Yard at 1086 E. Walnut Road. Residents are also welcome to keep their bins for other household uses.

DO I HAVE TO PUT MY RECYCLABLES IN MY CART?

Yes. Crews will only collect recyclables placed loose in the cart. Do not place materials on the ground, in a bin, or in bags. No plastic bags should ever be placed in your recycling cart.

HOW DO I SET MY CART OUT PROPERLY ON COLLECTION DAY?

Place your cart on the curb by 6:00 am on your collection day or the night before. Make sure the cart is accessible to the crew. Do not place it behind trees, mailboxes, lamp posts, or parked cars.

WHAT IF MY CART IS STOLEN OR DAMAGED?

Call Vineland's Public Works Department at 856-794-4250 or Vineland Solid Waste Department at 856-794-4089. Additionally, a police report should be filed immediately upon vandalism or theft.
