The Regular Work Session of the City Council of the City of Vineland was called to order by the President, Anthony R. Fanucci.

Councilwoman Gonzalez stated that she will be providing the background information regarding a commending resolution for two members of the Vineland Municipal Alliance.

Councilman Spinelli reported that a VDID meeting is planned for tomorrow. Councilwoman Calakos noted that there hasn't been much conversation to City Council from VDID. Councilman Spinelli would like reports from all departments more routinely.

Councilwoman Calakos observed that the former Vineland Savings & Loan building next to Landis Theater is not well maintained and suggested it might be good for theater parking. President Fanucci cautioned that it is a ratable and we need to take a careful look at it.
