VINELAND SENIOR CENTER RENOVATIONS



The Vineland Senior Center is an important part of our community providing a warm and welcoming environment where seniors can socialize and participate in programming that helps them stay healthy and engaged.

The existing historic building dates back to 1903 and has not undergone any significant upgrades since the Senior Center was opened in the 1970s. But that is about to change with a renovation now underway that will still retain the beautiful character of the original Vineland Library, while providing modern features.

Work will involve exterior repairs to water-damaged walls, along with interior work on both levels including updated office space, bathrooms, kitchen, flooring, and furniture. The project is expected to be completed in October. During this period, Senior Center staff will be operating at the Main and Oak Fire Station, where they will provide some activities.

"I want to thank the members of City Council for their support of this project," Mayor Fanucci said. "By restoring and enhancing this beloved space, we can preserve its rich history while adapting it to meet the evolving needs of our senior community."

SLINGSHOT TRANSPORTATION OPENS VINELAND FACILITY

Vineland's emergence as a major logistics hub got another boost with the opening of the new Slingshot Transportation facility on Garden Road. The recently completed 256,000 square foot facility includes office space, docks, cold storage coolers, a state-of-the-art packing room, and a local transportation fleet.

It also gives us the ability to grow our sorting, regrading, and packaging services to a much larger market."

"Vineland logistics operations offer the quality warehousing and value-added services these customers are looking for. Slingshot Transportation will be an important addition to our existing operations. We are pleased to welcome them to Vineland."
