# **VINELAND RECEIVES GRANT FOR BROADBAND UTILITY**

We are proud to announce that the City of Vineland is a recipient of the New Jersey Broadband Infrastructure Deployment Equity grant (NJBIDE) in the amount of \$3.7 million. NJBIDE is a competitive grant initiative designed to help bring high-speed internet access to areas in New Jersey with limited or no connectivity. Initial testing by the Broadband Utility is currently planned for the first quarter of 2026. Specific testing locations are still being finalized, but they are expected to include industrial, educational, and health related locations.

"Broadband access is essential infrastructure for any smart city," said Mayor Anthony Fanucci. "We recognized the limitations of private-sector broadband providers in ensuring equitable access in our community, so we created a Municipal Broadband Utility to develop a Vineland specific network. The plan the Broadband Utility is developing will incorporate existing public infrastructure where feasible to reduce costs, employing a mix of fiber-optic and wireless technologies for optimal coverage and performance. Our team has been working hard with both federal and state entities to secure available grant funding for the project, so we are thrilled those efforts have now paid off. We will continue to seek additional opportunities as they arise."

The final Cumberland County Household Hazardous Waste and Document Shredding Day (HHW) of 2025 will be held on Saturday, September 13 from 8:00 am until 2:00 pm at the Cumberland County Solid Waste Complex located at 169 Jesse Bridge Road.

This event is limited to Cumberland County residents only and is free of charge. Proper ID is required at check-in. Businesses (including home-based businesses), institutions, non-profits, and non-county residents are not eligible and should contact appropriate companies for hazardous waste disposal and document shredding needs.

Check the chart for items that will be accepted. Freon, CFCs/refrigerators, air conditioners, coolers, tires, concrete, and wood are not accepted at HHW events. Residents can properly dispose of these times at the Solid Waste Complex. Also not accepted is latex paint, as it is water-based and non-hazardous. To properly dispose of latex paint, add clay-based kitty litter to the can, stir, and let dry until no longer pourable. Replace the lid and dispose of the paint can with your household trash.
