Chestnut Avenue Safety Improvements and Rehabilitation

PROJECT GOAL

The goal of the proposed project is to enhance safety for all users along the 2.25-mile portion of Chestnut Avenue. The Chestnut Avenue project proposes implementing a "road diet" for the corridor between Delsea Drive (NJ Route 47) and Main Road (CR 555) located within the City of Vineland, Cumberland County, New Jersey. Under existing conditions, the roadway is a 4-lane multilane highway with no paved shoulders. It is proposed to convert the existing configuration into a 2-lane highway with two (2) 11' lanes, one (1) 13.5' center two-way left turn lane, and 4' paved shoulders. The project will also feature a 6' and 8' shared use path on the eastbound and westbound sides of the roadway, respectively.

PROJECT LOCATION/DURATION

Length: 2.25 miles

Boundary: Chestnut Avenue between Delsea Drive (NJ

Route 47) and Main Road (CR 555)

Start Date: Construction is anticipated to begin in 2027.

This will be an opportunity for the public to learn about the project, ask questions, and provide feedback to the project team.
