Proposed Improvements

- Overhead flashing beacons
- Dual/oversized stop signs
- Transverse rumble strips
- Lane/shoulder delineation
- Raised medians
- High visibility crosswalks/mid-block crosswalks

Please join us in learning more about the project and provide feedback on the proposed improvements to East Avenue. Visitors may attend anytime during the hours specified in-person to review project information and meet with the project team along with City of Vineland staff.

East Avenue from Walnut Road to Elmer Street was targeted for improvements because of its current safety risks and design deficiencies. With a high presence of bicycle and pedestrian crashes as well as crashes that resulted in injury, the East Avenue corridor was the third highest ranked bicycle/pedestrian corridor in Cumberland County based on network crash screening.

- Lighting improvements at pedestrian crossings
- Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs)
- Sidewalk Improvements
- Drop off/pick up zone for school buses only
- Signage and striping improvements
- Advance warning signs
- ADA curb ramp/driveway improvements
