GREEN ACRES PROGRAM: PARK DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION FITNESS IMPROVEMENTS AT HOWARD PAGLIUGHY PARK

PURPOSE:

The City of Vineland is seeking funding through the State of NJ Green Acres Program for fitness improvements at Howard Pagliughi Park at 2245 E. Magnolia Road.

PROJECT SCOPE

The City of Vineland is seeking funding through the State of NJ Green Acres Program for fitness and recreation improvements, including the installation of an ADA-accessible, senior-friendly outdoor fitness station package consists of 14 units (13 separate stations), the construction of two pickleball courts, the installation of a walking track within an existing open area of the park, and ADA-compliant upgrades to existing parking facilities located adjacent to the project area at Howard Pagliughi Park.
