## VINELAND INDUSTRIAL SECTOR SEES EXPANSION

Vineland-based BRIDOR, a leading producer of premium bakery products and Viennese pastries sold in more than 100 countries, has invested \$200 million in a new R & D Culinary Academy and new equipment which will double the bakery’s production capabilities.

“By strengthening our Vineland operations, we’re able to scale efficiently while preserving the craftsmanship, quality, and consistency that define BRIDOR. Vineland plays a critical role in our growth today and well into the future,” said Eric Juillet de Saint Lager, CEO of BRIDOR N.A.

Additionally, Precision laboratory glass manufacturer Glastron Inc. is set to modernize and nearly double the size of its facility at 510 N. West Blvd. The project calls for an 8,700-square-foot addition, without enlarging the roughly 1.9-acre campus. Glastron is part of the Pennsylvania based Restek company which views their Vineland presence as important because of the area’s ‘significant glass manufacturing talent pool.’”

“We are proud to see companies like BRIDOR and Glastron continue to grow and invest in Vineland,” said Mayor Anthony Fanucci. “Their commitment to innovation and expansion not only strengthens our local economy but also highlights Vineland as a premier location for advanced manufacturing and food production.”

This includes gas cans, oil containers, and boxes/bins for shredding. Participants will not be able to stay and watch their documents be shredded.

The events are free to all Vineland residents. Non-profits, commercial, and home-based businesses are not eligible to participate. Clean out your garage and/or basements and get rid of your old cleaning or yard chemicals, outdated electronics, oil-based paints, and more! No Latex paint will be accepted.
