ORDINANCE NO. 2026-17, ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021-42, AS AMENDED, CHAPTER 266 ARTICLE I, SECTION 266-3 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VINELAND ENTITLED CANNABIS ESTABLISHMENTS; LICENSING, APPLICATIONS, QUALIFICATIONS AND STANDARDS.

In 2022, City Council established licensing requirements for cannabis businesses and the number of licenses allowed for each Class of Cannabis business. Currently, there exists two Class V Cannabis Retailer licenses and City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the City of Vineland to create a third Class V Cannabis Retailer license for possible issuance. This ordinance shall amend the above section of the code to allow for not more than three Class V retail Cannabis licenses.

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on its first reading at a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland conducted on March 24, 2026 and is scheduled for a second reading, public hearing, and adoption at a meeting of said Council scheduled for Tuesday, April 14, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in City Council Chambers, City Hall, Seventh & Wood Streets, Vineland, NJ.
