ORDINANCE NO. 2026-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98-42, AS
AMENDED, CHAPTER 372 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY
OF VINELAND ENTITLED FIRE PREVENTION.

In 1998, City Council adopted the ordinance establishing local enforcement of the New Jersey Uniform Fire Code. Whereby, from time to time, The Division of Fire Safety will conduct field monitoring visits to ensure compliance. A report dated August 8, 2025 found some areas inconsistent with the Uniform Fire code and required the City of Vineland to make appropriate changes. Therefore, this ordinance shall amend Chapter 372 of the code to add a provision of a successor in the absence of the Fire Official and update the Permits; Fees and Penalties section to add “Collection of Fees” and how all fees and delinquencies are collected.

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on its first reading at a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland conducted on March 24, 2026 and is scheduled for a second reading, public hearing, and adoption at a meeting of said Council scheduled for Tuesday, April 14, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in City Council Chambers, City Hall, Seventh & Wood Streets, Vineland, NJ.
