BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENT AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the City of Vineland, in the County of Cumberland, State of New Jersey on April 14, 2026 and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such bond ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full bond ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO VARIOUS ROADS AND RELATED DRAINAGE AND SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE CITY OF VINELAND, IN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$10,000,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$9,500,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE CITY TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF

Purpose: Improvements to various roads and related drainage and sidewalk improvements, all as set forth on a list on file in the City Clerk's Office and the Engineer's Office, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

Appropriation: \$10,000,000

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$9,500,000

Grant Appropriated: N/A

Section 20 Costs: \$1,500,000

Useful Life: 10 years
