

**Loose grass clippings**  
can **NOT** be placed at the curb  
or in the street at any time!

**ATTENTION,  
all residents  
of the City of  
Vineland!**

**All grass clippings MUST be bagged or in your  
city-issued trash cart.**

**Placing loose grass at the curb  
or roadway is prohibited.**

Loose grass causes problems such as odor  
and mosquitoes, but most importantly it  
washes into and clogs storm water drains.

New Jersey Storm Water Regulations state  
we can not place any yard waste closer  
than 10 feet from a storm drain or inlet  
— this includes leaves and branches.



***City of Vineland Trash Collection  
Regulations for proper pick-up of grass:***

Grass clippings must be placed in trash bags,  
but not mixed with leaves or other debris.  
Four (4) bags outside of trash cart allowed  
per trash day. If more than four, place them  
inside trash cart. Bags must not weigh more  
than 40 lbs!
