ORDINANCE NO. 2026-40, ORDINANCE RELEASING, VACATING, AND EXTINGUISHING ANY PUBLIC RIGHTS IN PORTIONS OF CERTAIN PAPER STREETS KNOWN AS COLUMBIA AVENUE AND WASHINGTON AVENUE.

The City of Vineland owns numerous small lots north of W. Weymouth Road which abut paper streets including Columbia and Washington Avenues. The City is under contract to purchase the rear portions of Block 132, Lot 18, Lot 19, Lot 21 and Lot 21. This ordinance shall, with the consolidation and purchase of the lots, and subdivision approval to create front on Weymouth Road, authorize the paper streets of Columbia Avenue and Washington Avenue be vacated.

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on its first reading at a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland conducted on June 9, 2026 and is scheduled for a second reading, public hearing, and adoption at a meeting of said Council scheduled for Tuesday, June 23, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in City Council Chambers, City Hall, Seventh & Wood Streets, Vineland, NJ.
