ORDINANCE NO. 2026-42

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2025-20, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2019-57 AND ORDINANCE 2022-49, AS AMENDED, CHAPTER 687, PART IV, ARTICLE XVIII OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VINELAND ENTITLED WATER-SEWER UTILITY; REIGHTS RESERVED; RATES.

Ordinance 20219-57 and Ordinance 2022-49 set forth rates to be charged to water usage and imposed a recovery clause to adjust for the escalation in emergency and treatment costs associated with the supply and distribution of City water to \$.4370250 per 1,000 gallons. As recommended by the Director of the Municipal Utilities, this ordinance shall remove the escalation calculator so if the cost exceeds the amount per 1,000 gallons, the Water Utility may assure the appropriate adjustment is made.

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on its first reading at a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland conducted on June 9, 2026 and is scheduled for a second reading, public hearing, and adoption at a meeting of said Council scheduled for Tuesday, June 23, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in City Council Chambers, City Hall, Seventh & Wood Streets, Vineland, NJ.
