ORDINANCE NO. 2026-44

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 130 AS AMENDED, CHAPTER 56 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VINELAND TITLED “AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR THE CITY OF VINELAND AND PROMULGATING RULES AND REGULATIONS THEREFORE.”

Ordinance No. 130 was adopted in 1954 to establish the Vineland Fire Department and has been amended from time to time, as needed, to better serve the residents of the City of Vineland. The Director of Fire-EMS and Chief of Department recommended to council that the ordinance be revised as to amend the address of fire headquarters to the newly constructed building located at 400 W. Plum Street; to establish within the department, a Professional Standards Unit and to amend the volunteer application age from eighteen to seventeen years of age to help recruit and retain interested residents.

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on its first reading at a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland conducted on June 23, 2026 and is scheduled for a second reading, public hearing, and adoption at a meeting of said Council scheduled for Tuesday, July 14, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in City Council Chambers, City Hall, Seventh & Wood Streets, Vineland, NJ.
