ORDINANCE NO. 2026-53

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NO PASSING ZONES ALONG A PORTION OF SPRING ROAD BETWEEN LINCOLN AVENUE AND MAPLE AVENUE.

This ordinance shall authorize as, recommended by the City Engineer, that No Passing Zones should be revised along Spring Road to reduce the length of permissive passing with the school zone near Walnut Road and vicinity of Ramano Park near Maple Avenue. The following No Passing Zones shall be revised and maintained:

| Spring Road           | Both        | From Lincoln Avenue to Chestnut Avenue                                                    |
| Spring Road           | Both        | From approximately 705 feet north of the northerly Curb line of Pell Lane to Maple Avenue |

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on its first reading at a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland conducted on July 14, 2026 and is scheduled for a second reading, public hearing, and adoption at a meeting of said Council scheduled for Tuesday, July 28, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in City Council Chambers, City Hall, Seventh & Wood Streets, Vineland, NJ.
