ORDINANCE NO. 2026-54

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 91-76, AS
AMENDED, CHAPTER 639, ARTICLE I OF THE CODE
OF THE CITY OF VINELAND ENTITLED PUBLIC
POOLS.

On October 22, 1991, Council adopted the above ordinance to promulgate regulations for recreational bathing and the like. Since adoption, a form called “cold plunge” or “cold water immersion” or “cold therapy” providing for therapeutic benefits but raises safety concerns. This ordinance shall amend the standards to define appropriate terms, require those under the age of 16 to be accompanied by an adult and require proper signage verbiage as identified in Section 639-1.1(d) and shall also require temperature parameters, depth markings, proper enclosures for outdoor units and requirements for circulation systems except for use in singer user units that do not perform backwash.

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on its first reading at a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland conducted on July 14, 2026 and is scheduled for a second reading, public hearing, and adoption at a meeting of said Council scheduled for Tuesday, July 28, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in City Council Chambers, City Hall, Seventh & Wood Streets, Vineland, NJ.
