ORDINANCE NO. 2026-58

ORDINANCE REMOVING CHAPTER 81 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF
VINELAND ENTITLED LANDIS THEATER FOUNDATION BOARD OF
DIRECTORS.

The Landis Theater has been restored as a historical landmark in the City of Vineland to be used as a venue for performing arts and other similar uses. The Landis Theater Foundation, Inc., a New Jersey Nonprofit Corporation, was formed to assist in the preservation, and operation of the Landis Theater as an historical icon of the City of Vineland and the Board of Directors have or are in the process of amending its bylaws which set forth the number, term, qualifications, and procedures for the appointment of membership to the Board of Directors; and

To better provide the Landis Theater Foundation, Inc. greater flexibility in the appointment and composition of its Board of Directors, it is reasonable, this ordinance shall delete and remove in its entirety Chapter 81 from the Vineland City Code.

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on its first reading at a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland conducted on July 28, 2026 and is scheduled for a second reading, public hearing, and adoption at a meeting of said Council scheduled for Tuesday, August 11, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in City Council Chambers, City Hall, Seventh & Wood Streets, Vineland, NJ.
