ORDINANCE NO. 2026-59

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 585, ARTICLE I OF THE
CODE OF THE CITY OF VINELAND ENTITLED CESSPOOLS
SO AS TO INCLUDE SEPTIC TANKS, HOLDING TANKS AND
SEEPAGE PITS THEREIN.

City Council acting as the Vineland Board of Health adopted Ordinance 9 in 1953 setting forth requirements for business operating cesspool cleaning services, however failed to include other individual subsurface sewerage disposal systems or non-discharge, non-soil treatment storage systems. With recommendation by the City's Health Officer, this ordinance shall authorize Council to amend Chapter 585 to include those above mentioned storage systems with the requirement for cleaning and reporting such sewer systems.

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on its first reading at a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland conducted on July 28, 2026 and is scheduled for a second reading, public hearing, and adoption at a meeting of said Council scheduled for Tuesday, August 11, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in City Council Chambers, City Hall, Seventh & Wood Streets, Vineland, NJ.
