ORDINANCE NO. 2026-63

ORDINANCE PERMITTING AND SETTING FORTH THE
REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PRODUCTION OF MOTION
PICTURES, TELEVISION AND SUCH OTHER FILMING IN THE
CITY OF VINELAND IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE NEW
JERSEY MOTION PICTURE AND TELEVISION COMMISSION
AND N.J.S.A. 34:1B-22, ET SEQ.

The New Jersey Legislature enacted the Motion Picture and Television Development Act, N.J.S.A. 34:1B-22 to promote the development of a strong motion picture and television industry in the State. Vineland City Council finds that the City of Vineland offers such unique opportunities and therefore intends upon facilitating motion pictures and television production by establishing a streamlined permitting process, designating a municipal film liaison and otherwise provides assurances of its willingness to cooperate with the Commission and such production companies. This Ordinance shall set forth the permitting process for motion pictures and television production for the City of Vineland.

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on its first reading at a meeting of the Council of the City of Vineland conducted on August 25, 2026 and is scheduled for a second reading, public hearing, and adoption at a meeting of said Council scheduled for Tuesday, September 8, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in City Council Chambers, City Hall, Seventh & Wood Streets, Vineland, NJ.
