U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY REVIEWS CLEANUP FOR THE VINELAND CHEMICAL SUPERFUND SITE

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is conducting its **fourth** five-year review of the Vineland Chemical Superfund site located in Vineland, Cumberland County, New Jersey. This review seeks to confirm that the cleanup conducted at the site continues to be protective of people's health and the environment.

EPA's cleanup approach includes using a pump and treat system, which involves using three to four extraction wells, operated by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, to address arsenic contamination in the groundwater. EPA is conducting biannual monitoring of sediment, surface water, and floodplain soil in the Blackwater Branch, and annual monitoring of Maurice River and Union Lake beaches.

A summary of the cleanup activities and an evaluation of their protectiveness will be included in the five-year review report. The report will be available by the end of **summer 2026**.

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of people's health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspecting the site and cleanup technologies;
- Reviewing monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records; and
- Determining if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.
